

OIL SYNDICATE REPORT 2019

In December 2018, the Syndicate was the victim of a Scam. Our usual supplier, UKAY Fuels, was going through a change of personnel, and did not actively participate in the bidding for the order, and so I went to a company which had been sending me e-mails and flyers for some time. They offered a good price, and the order was placed with them, but it became clear as the delivery due time approached, near to Christmas, that things were not good. I pulled the contract, and placed it with Goff, as I knew that they would be able to deliver quickly, and they did a very good job indeed.

If anybody ever sees any advertisements by Evolution Oil, I and several other residents would be very pleased to hear about them. They still owe several people money, for pre-paid but undelivered fuel. The authorities have been informed about the scam.

The February 2019 order included UKAY in the bidding, but they have lost all the staff whom I knew and worked with before, and could not match the price offered by Goff, who were awarded the contract. Goff's delivery time was also far quicker than UKAY's used to be.

The February order was small this year, due no doubt to the spring-like weather, especially compared to 2018, when The Beast from the East made life a misery.

The next order will be in July this year.
