

**REDGRAVE, BOTESDALE & RICKINGHALL TWINNING ASSOCIATION
REPORT 2017**

We received a delegation visit from the Tinteniatic Association early in the year to look at ways of re-energising the Association. The delegation met with the Chairman and Treasurer as well as representatives from the Parish Council, school and other interested parties. A series of adverts and fliers, together with a letter from the Tinteniatic Association were agreed and published to try and encourage interest with the association, resulting in a single offer of French lessons.

The Chairman and Treasurer, being the only committee members left, visited Tinteniatic in July 2016 to meet with the Headteacher of one of the local primary schools. The objective was to try and encourage a link between our local schools and those of Tinteniatic. Unfortunately none of these have been taken up.

It therefore has to be assumed that the parishioners of Botesdale, Rickinghall and Redgrave are no longer interested in being part of a twinning association, and an AGM will be held in due course to wind the Association up.

It is assumed that the Parish Councils will take the necessary steps to remove the Twinning signs from the village entrances..
