

BOLLARDS AT POST OFFICE

Too many restrictions already in place.

No-where else to park to use the shop.

Bollards would make the post office inaccessible to those with disabilities who drive to the P.O: Better a designated disabled parking space.

No need.

If we want to retain the Post Office, we should not make it more difficult to stop there if driving, as many people do.

I would sooner see a simple double yellow line outside the Newsagents.

Won't solve the problem they will just park on the road.

Unnecessary as it is already contrary to the highway code to park on the pavement and this needs to be enforced.

It addresses only part of the problem whereas double yellow lines would achieve the same result and reduce the congestion hazarding moving traffic and pedestrians.

Painted zig zag "no stopping" lines could be applied to the front of the newsagent/PO if bollards are too expensive or unsightly.

We think that bollards in front of the post office are quite a good idea but yellow lines or both would be even better as bollards alone would just result in more obstruction of the road.

It is imperative that something is done to stop motorists driving then parking outside the post office. I personally have been almost hit twice. Is a zebra crossing possible in addition to bollards?

If you place bollards, the shop will never sell and we could lose the paper/PO shop.

Most cars I see outside the post office are on the road, not on the pavement so bollards would be useless.

Please do not put bollards in front of the Post Office. Delivery of newspapers plus selling of shop made hugely difficult if not impossible.

The introduction of bollards outside the PO would lead to a reduction of business and a possible loss of this valuable village asset. It is, therefore, not necessary.

I definitely think there should be bollards outside of the PO but even when cars park on the road outside the PO it causes congestion on the road.

Although I know parking outside the PO, especially when on pavement, can be a problem, if stop this it will mean less people go to the PO & shop. If this means potential to lose the PO/shop this would be far more of an inconvenience.

Priority: Bollards in front of newsagents/PO.
